Interim reference

This interim reference has been translated from German. The German original takes precedence.

Mr Govind Estermann from Rickenbach (Canton Lucerne), born on 13 December 1967,

Since 1 January 2006, Mr Estermann has managed the Advanced Accounting & Reporting team in Zurich for Global Wealth Management & Business Banking's information technology area. As project manager, he is primarily responsible for the following tasks:

- Managing technical and personnel issues for a team consisting of three employees and three external software vendors
- Managing projects for an application-based fulfilment of complex client needs for investment accounting relating to high net worth individuals, foundations and trusts
- Managing releases in cooperation with external software vendors
- Managing releases for internal applications (Trustgate, eLM, Recon Tool, various import/export modules, Client Reporting Tool, Wealth Report)
- Managing software components for "ePOCA private banking" for international release (Switzerland, Jersey, Bahamas, Cayman Islands, Singapore) and "AAWI" (sole area of application: Switzerland)
- Advising the Advanced Accounting & Reporting (AAR) business (department for creating client investment accounting and investment portfolio analyses) with regard to IT needs
- Providing first through third level production support for AAR's business (overseeing operations
 of an investment accounting department with 25 employees)

Furthermore, he has been or still is responsible for the following special tasks:

- Assisting with client needs analyses and business specifications for the development of reporting products
- Eliminating operational risks pursuant to UBS's Operational Risk Framework Standards by linking AAR solutions to the internal authorisation system, creating a first cut risk analysis, application upgrades for audit logging and user authentication, and implementation of banking roles for business and IT
- Entering applications into Small Applications (basis for realisation of wealth reports and ePOCA load module on .net)
- Assisting with end client reporting strategy for the year 2009 and beyond
- Carrying out a feasibility study for global use of bookkeeping applications used in Asia for consolidated reporting across all booking centres (leveraging SSP in Singapore, Hong Kong and Switzerland)

In recognition of his good performance and commitment, Mr Estermann was promoted to the rank of Associate Director with effect from 1 March 2007.
